Project size block

Sewing machine in good repair, extra needles. Sewing supplies. Straight handled rotary cutter with 28mm wheel, mat and ruler.

Option 1. Template fee \$12, required

Fabrics

Background – One and ½ yard – traditionally muslin or shirtings, you may use anything you choose, but “white on white” fabric is often too thin for a good background. Your fabric must be big enough to cut 20” long pieces on the grain.

Feathers, Triangles and Centers – fat quarters of 1 – 24 different small scale prints. The instructor used early 1900s reproduction fabrics and conversation prints. You may use anything you choose. Fabric must be big enough to cut pieces 8” long on grain. Important – sizes and shapes of the pieces should be consistent for easy stacking and cutting.

Fat quarters would be plenty for class, if you just want to make a sample

Option 2 – purchase a pre-cut kit from the instructor for \$45. Project size is four 17 ½” blocks.

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
