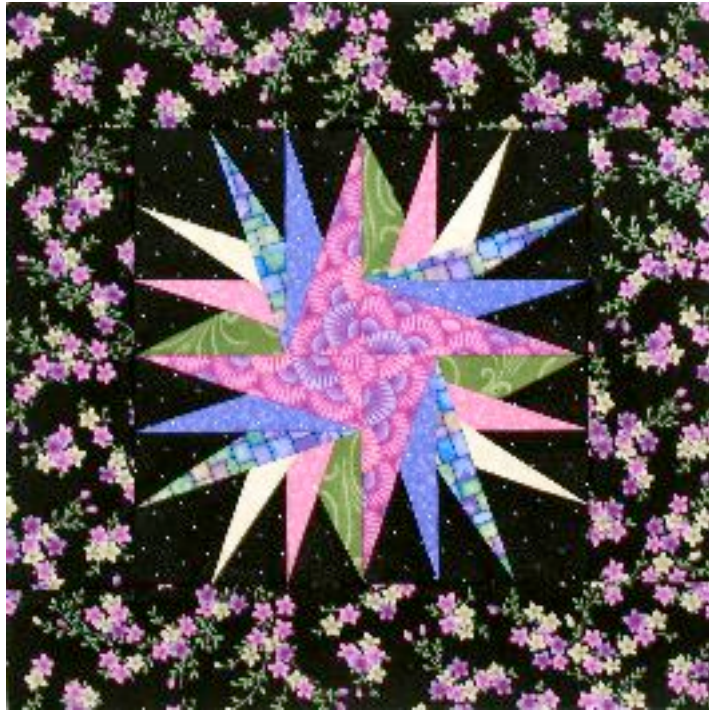


Supply List for Perfect Points Full-Day Workshop with Carol Doak



Learn the tips and tricks for producing perfect points using the easy paper piecing method. Using one of the block designs from Carol's newest book, [300 Paper-Pieced Quilt Blocks](#), you will learn about fabric choices, joining blocks, matching and reducing bulk at the points. Even if you are new to patchwork, your points will be perfect!

Supplies:

Sewing Machine in good working order equipped with a 90/14 needle, thread. (Bring along your knee lift if your sewing machine has that feature.)

Rotary cutter, small pair of scissors, rotary mat, 6" square and 6" x 12" rotary rulers (Ominigrd suggested), small stick-on note pad.

Flat headed or small-headed pins

6" Add-A-Quarter ruler

I will be supplying all your foundations

Fabric:

Background –

4" x 44" strip of non-directional very dark or very light tone-on-tone or solid fabric.

Rays –

3" x 44" strips of 6 different contrasting solid or tone-on-tone fabrics.

Border –

1 strip, 2 1/2" x 44".
